A new enhanced version of the NR9925 Key Points has been produced with industry support and collaboration.

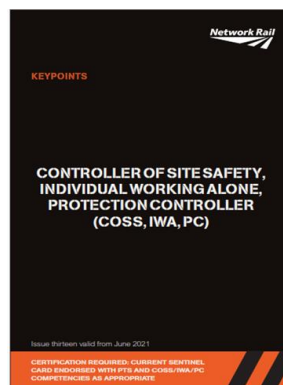
