

## **Safety Hour Discussion Pack**

### **Topic:**

## Purpose of the discussion:

Why has this been chosen as a Safety Hour topic? Is there a risk, incident or change that the team need to be aware of? To raise awareness of charitable giving activity (e.g. volunteering and fundraising), which has a positive impact on employee health and wellbeing, team building and personal skills development, contributing to a workforce more engaged in and able to communicate safety messages.
