Five people are killed on UK roads every day and many more are seriously injured – and while we can't stop all the accidents, we can help you ensure your vehicle is as safe as it can be.

Every driver is responsible for the safety of their vehicle and their passengers, as well as other drivers and pedestrians.

Three simple ways to ensure your vehicle is safe to drive.

1. **Use the CheckedSafe® app** for your first use checks.
2. **Report every collision**, whatever the cause and however minor.
3. **Book in regular washes** through the GoWash app.

A little love and attention will keep you and your passengers safer and help reduce breakdowns.

Failing to use the CheckedSafe® app for your first use checks puts everyone at risk of injury or worse.




Drivers are personally responsible for:

1. carrying out first use checks
2. logging any damage, faults or issues on the CheckedSafe® app
3. any consequences that follow if they fail to do points 1 and 2.

collision.**

Give your vehicle some extra love – report every collision, whatever the cause and however minor.

Damaged vehicles are a danger to everyone on the road – and you could be held responsible for any consequences.

You might not be able to see any significant damage, or think it's particularly dangerous, but it's always better to be safe than sorry.

How to report a collision:

1. stop safely and report the collision immediately
2. contact the Network Rail Driver Helpline (0343 351 9128) and your Line Manager
3. report all damage, thefts and incidents within 24 hours – no matter how minor.

Collisions happen – reporting isn't about assigning blame, it's about getting things fixed and keeping everyone safe.

Keep it clean.**

Your vehicle looks after you, mile after mile, so it's only fair that you return the favour.

Book in regular washes through the GoWash app and keep it clean and safe – a dirty vehicle reduces visibility and could hide dangerous defects.



Book in a wash with the GoWash app.

- Use the app to locate a hand car wash close to you – you'll need to be nearby for it to work.
- Add your vehicle.
- Enter your registration once and it's saved for next time – just make sure it's a fleet vehicle and under 3.5 tonnes.
- Select your service.
- Choose the right wash for your vehicle. Some options or add-ons may be limited depending on your account.
- Pay on the app.
- Select 'Pay with Fleet Account' and you're good to go – no need to pay on site.
- Drive in and get it cleaned.
- Show confirmation if needed and let the team take care of the rest.
