Construction work sites: “What good looks like”

This document has been created by Network Rail Infrastructure Projects (IP) Safety Improvement Team in collaboration with its suppliers and establishes a visual benchmark which all our sites should achieve.

Within IP there are a number of guideline documents across its functions/regions for the design and management of project worksites (compounds and work areas). These guidelines vary, resulting in an inconsistent approach across IP and have the potential to cause confusion for the supply chain.

The purpose of this document is to provide a single worksite guideline across Network Rail IP which is aimed at all projects and suppliers. We expect for example roles such as Construction Managers/Supervisors, Project Managers, and Health and Safety Managers/Advisors to use this document as a tool for discussion and briefings. This document should also be used to support activities such as general inspections.

Use any issues you identify in the document as a discussion and learning point. This is a live document which shall be reviewed regularly.
