Transition to Sentinel

Fact Sheet 3 – SMTH Competence Levels

Between now and 1 March 2025 some of the SMTH competences are being transitioned into Sentinel for SMTH testers who are not employees of Network Rail.

This fact sheet sets out the competence levels which are applied to each of the SMTH competences and the activities each level permits an individual to perform on Network Rail infrastructure.
