Immediate action required

This briefing is compulsory for all staff (Network Rail and contractors) that hold the following Traction Power Distribution competences:

- DIST Level A
- DIST Level B ACi. or Level B ACi+DCi
- DIST Level C

Completion of the briefing must be logged as LC DIST REBRIEF against the individual's competence profile in Oracle (NR staff) or Sentinel (Contractors)

The briefing must be completed and recorded in Sentinel or Oracle by 29th July 2019.

Failure to complete the briefing by this date will result in the individual's DIST Level A, B or C competence being taken down until the briefing is completed and logged.

Part of this briefing will also introduce the SENSES reminder (picture above) for entering distribution locations. The A3 SENSES poster should be printed and displayed on Delivery Unit notice boards and other relevant locations.

Within Network Rail, the recommended roles to facilitate and deliver this briefing are; IMDM, IME, EPME or E&P RAM, HoD (E&P), DPE or SPE.

The facilitator is not required to hold the DIST competences to deliver this briefing but support can be requested from STE if required.
